Eligibility Criteria:

The Contest is judged by a panel of esteemed professionals from the architectural, interior design and kitchen design disciplines. All votes and decisions of the panel are final.

Applicants and projects must be based in Western Australia. Open to all local designers, architects, cabinet makers, builders and developers. Must be a legal resident of Western Australia.

Projects can include new home builds, extensions or renovations. Display suites do not qualify for entry. The design and construction of the project must be completed between 9.00am 1 July 2022 to 30th June 2024 at 11.59pm.

Images - Ensure images are of the highest quality resolution with a minimum of 5 and a maximum of 10 images. Format must be jpg or png format. Additional 'before' images can be submitted for renovations, but are not a requirement. *Max file size is 10MB. Please include the photographer's name in your entry so the photography can be credited if publicised. Contact your photographer to also ensure you have copyright permission for the Hart & Co. Awards Program promotional use. The entrant has or will obtain all necessary and appropriate rights and licences to grant the licence to Hart & Co. to use any Client Material & Imagery provided.

Project Brief - Details are the project brief and outcome are to be included in our entry form such as; description about your project including important aspects of your clients brief, challenges faced and anything unique about the project. There is also a section for including companies/individuals you collaborated with such as builders, cabinet makers and/or kitchen companies.

Working Drawings - Include a floor plan, elevations and cabinetry plans.

Specifications - A list and description of key materials used in the project, for example; cabinetry materials, appliances, colours and finishes, splashback, flooring etc.

Eligibility for **Emerging Talent** Category;

Entrants must be studying at a recognised Australian University, TAFE or secondary college. Concepts and University projects are eligible for entry. Complete a project brief (see above) based on what could be a potential 'real life' project.
