

Hart & Co. Kitchen Design Awards

Terms & Conditions of Entry

1. Project Eligibility Period

The Promoter is Hart & Co. WA Pty Ltd (ABN 18 620 834 013) of 52 Guthrie St, Osborne Park WA 6017.

The Project Eligibility Period is **1 July 2024 to 30 June 2026**. Eligible projects must have been completed during this period. Entries must be submitted online via **hartandcoappliances.com.au/awards**.

2. Eligibility

- The Hart & Co. Kitchen Design Awards are open exclusively to entrants whose principal place of business or study is in Western Australia.
 - Eligible entrants include kitchen designers, architects, interior designers, builders, developers, cabinet makers, students and others directly involved in residential kitchen design and construction.
 - The **Emerging Talent – Best Kitchen Design Concept** category is open to students enrolled in a recognised Western Australian secondary school, TAFE or tertiary institution.
 - Non-residential (including showroom, retail, commercial, hospitality, recreational and educational projects) are not eligible.
 - Employees and associated parties of the Promoter are excluded.
 - Projects must be completed during the **Project Eligibility Period**.
 - Each project may only be entered once and in one Hart & Co. Kitchen Design Awards program.
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3. Entry Requirements

- Multiple entries are permitted per eligible entrant.
 - Entries must be the entrant's original concept with all necessary approvals from the kitchen owner and any intellectual property holders.
 - Entries must not infringe third-party rights.
 - Entrants grant the Promoter a royalty-free licence to use submitted materials for promotional purposes.
 - All entries become the property of the Promoter and will not be returned.
 - No identifying names or branding are to appear within the submission content.
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4. Submission Materials

Each entry must include:

- 5 to 10 high-resolution images (no people; .jpg or .png; maximum 10MB each). PDF images are not accepted.
- Project description written in English.
- List of appliances used, including brand and supplier.
- Contributor details.
- Optional elevations or CAD drawings (required for the **Emerging Talent – Best Kitchen Design Concept** category).
- CGI, renders, AI-generated or materially AI-altered images are not permitted (except in the **Emerging Talent – Best Kitchen Design Concept** category).
- Images must not display third-party trademarks or logos (excluding Hart & Co.).
- Poor quality or inappropriate submissions may be disqualified.

Best Kitchen Transformation Category

Entries in the **Best Kitchen Transformation** category must also include:

- A minimum of two "before" images of the original kitchen.
- Corresponding "after" images of the completed project.
- A brief description outlining the design brief, key challenges and the overall transformation achieved.

Category Value Determination

To determine the appropriate **Kitchen Design Excellence** category, calculate the total project value (including GST) based on:

- Kitchen cabinetry
- Benchtops
- Splashbacks
- Appliances

Do not include costs associated with building works, trades, flooring, lighting or other unrelated expenses.

Projects should be entered into one of the following categories:

- Kitchen Design Excellence – up to \$80,000
- Kitchen Design Excellence – \$80,000–\$150,000
- Kitchen Design Excellence – over \$150,000

Fisher & Paykel Kitchen Design Excellence Eligibility

Entries in the **Fisher & Paykel Kitchen Design Excellence** category must include a minimum of two major Fisher & Paykel appliances, including at least one oven or cooker, plus a cooktop, refrigeration, dishwasher or rangehood.

5. Categories

Entries may be submitted under one or more of the following categories:

- Kitchen Design Excellence – up to \$80,000
 - Kitchen Design Excellence – \$80,000 - \$150,000
 - Kitchen Design Excellence – over \$150,000
 - Best Kitchen Transformation
 - Fisher & Paykel Kitchen Design Excellence
 - People's Choice – Kitchen Design Excellence
 - Emerging Talent – Best Kitchen Design Concept
 - The Hart & Co. Designer of the Year is selected from the winners of the three Kitchen Design Excellence categories and the Best Kitchen Transformation category.
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6. Judging & Shortlisting

- A professional judging panel will assess all eligible entries.
 - Judges may initially shortlist entries through discussion and consensus before applying the published judging criteria to determine finalists and winners.
 - The published judging criteria provide the framework for evaluating shortlisted entries and assist the panel in distinguishing between closely matched projects.
 - Four finalists will be selected in each judged category and notified prior to the Awards Event.
 - Winners will be announced at the Awards Event.
 - The **People's Choice – Kitchen Design Excellence** winner will be determined by public voting via a social media campaign.
 - All judging decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into.
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7. Prize Values

- \$3,000 for each category winner.
 - \$1,000 for **Emerging Talent – Best Kitchen Design Concept**.
 - Bonus \$2,000 for **Hart & Co. Designer of the Year**.
 - Prizes are not transferable or exchangeable.
 - Additional prizes may be awarded and announced at the Awards Event.
 - Entries failing to comply with these Terms may be disqualified and forfeit any prize.
 - In the event of a tie, the prize will be divided equally between the winners.
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8. General Conditions

- Entries that breach these Terms may be disqualified.
- The Promoter reserves the right to verify entry details and request supporting evidence.

- Entrants indemnify the Promoter against any third-party claims relating to their submission.
 - The Promoter is not liable for any loss or damage suffered in connection with the Awards except where required by law.
 - The Promoter reserves the right to modify, suspend or cancel the Awards due to unforeseen circumstances.
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9. Privacy & Publicity

- By entering, participants consent to their submission, name, likeness and materials being used by the Promoter for promotional purposes without additional compensation.
 - Personal information is collected for the administration of the Awards and related marketing activities. Refer to the Hart & Co. Privacy Policy for further details.
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10. Legal

- These Terms are governed by the laws of Western Australia.
- If any provision is found to be unlawful or unenforceable, the remaining provisions will continue in full force and effect.

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
